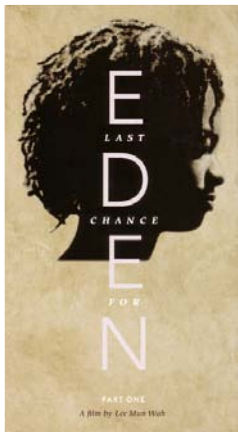

The Color of Fear 3 is an intimate conversation on the issues of what it is to be gay in this society and the impact it has on their sense of safety and identity. Through personal stories and interactions, we have a glimpse into the fears, the stereotypes, and moral issues that are dividing and confronting us today.



Last Chance for Eden 1

Last Chance for Eden 1 is about nine women and men who spend two weekends together talking about racism. On camera for twenty-four hours, they struggle to find a way to understand each other's differences. In the second half, they ask each other questions they have always wanted answered. Their responses and reactions are compelling and revealing, but also intimate and honest.

Last Chance for Eden 2 is about nine women and men confronting the issues of sexism in their lives and relationships. The women discuss their experiences concerning safety, sexism, and sexual harassment in the workplace, as well as the role the media plays in perpetuating sexism and male privilege.



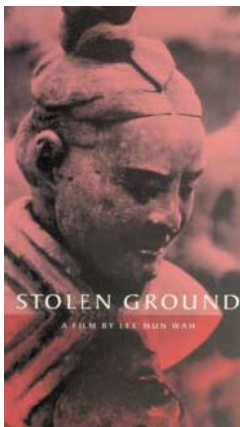

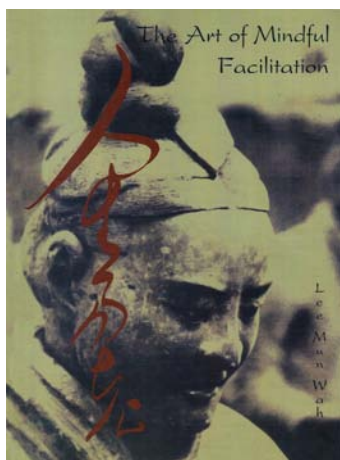

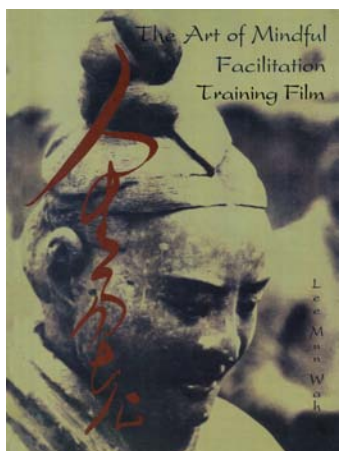
