1. What are the dates for the 2009 FPC Conference & Policy Meeting?

2. Where will the conference be held?

The conference will be held in Washington, DC.

3. What is the purpose for the 2009 FPC Conference & Federal Policy Meeting?

The purpose of this conference is to provide NAR's New Federal Political Coordinators (FPCs) with training support to prepare them for the 111th Congress. FPCs who have been appointed have the option of attending this conference or on-line training. New FPCs are required to attend the conference. The conference is also designed to provide NAR's 2009 GOVAFF/CPA Committee/Forum Leadership, State Association Executives, and 2009 State Presidents a review of NAR's public policy agenda, a forum for discussion of the Association's 2009 strategic focus, and approaches to accomplishing policy goals identified by NAR's policy-making committees.

State Executive Officer:

6. Should I book my own airfare?

Yes. When we send the registration link in the middle of December you will be provided with contact information for NAR's travel agency so you may book your flight. If NAR is covering your flight, the cost of the flight will be directly billed to NAR. You may also book your own flight.

7. When will registration be available for the 2009 FPC Conference & Policy Meeting?
