Discussion Questions

Discuss how the obligations to present evidence and to cooperate with any professional standards proceeding or investigation actually help promote the interests of consumers. (Article 14)

Could a REALTOR® be found in violation of the Code of Ethics by two different associations based on complaints involving the same transaction or event? (Standard of Practices 14-1 and 14-4)

May REALTORS® disclose allegations, findings, or decisions arising from any ethics or arbitration hearing? (Standard of Practice 14-2)

Why are REALTORS® ethically obligated to not “forward” or “resend” emails known to include false or misleading statements about competitors? (Standard of Practice 15-2)

Review the two Case Interpretations that help explain Article 15.
